For sure, accidentality is more unbelievable because creating a car without a creator is much easier than creating a vast systemized universe without a creator!

We can't believe the story of the car because there must be a creator for everything, and nothing can happen accidentally. We also need reasonable clarification or justification for everything to accept its existence. When we say there is a creator, we give a logical and reasonable explanation for the existence of this marvelous universe. This magnificent creation can't be found by no one!

Let's go deeper with further examples from our real life. In general, secularists reject the idea of religious guts or instinct, but such an instinct does exist. Many examples from our life can be given in this area. Belief contributes to boosting the quality of our lives as it calls for great values such as helping others and cooperating with other people to build good societies. It calls people to be helpful and induces them to support and rehabilitate the individuals who have certain problems in order to make them good and active members of society. Belief, which is part of

religion, calls its followers to be honest, loyal, fair, peaceful and deal with other people respectfully in addition to constantly improving their morality, leading a pure life, and helping others lead a similar life, too.

It also orders all sons to deal well with their parents even if the parents are non-believers and the sons are believers. Religion and belief order parents to be kind to their kids and order the sons to take care of their parents till the last moment of their lives.

To provide a better life for its followers, belief also rectifies the conduct of people and orders them to be honest because they are always watched by Almighty Allah. When they have such a feeling, people even attempt to complete all their tasks perfectly whether there are supervisors to check their work or not. This is a significant incentive for them because the supervisor is always there. Consequently, belief improves performance and helps believers avoid stress since it calls people to work hard and professionally in order to please their Creator. While abiding by such instructions, people will surely be more productive, beneficial, and better society individuals.

Religion and belief call for all these great values which are adopted and backed by modernity. This advancement distracted our attention from important issues and made our life too busy to the extent that a lot of people don't have time even to think about their private life. Chapter Three

Immortality

Immortality has been an obsession or dream for a lot of people since the dawn of history. Since thousands of years philosophers, scholars and heroes have been looking for immortality and exerted great efforts to find out the secrets or the reasons that might lead to fulfilling such a great aspiration. People also used to write stories about that and fabricated tales to persuade others that this aspiration is accessible. Some ancient stories highlighted the idea of elixir as this material, according to them, would help those who drink it live forever and become immortal with an eternal youth.

Immortality has also been underscored by both literature and religion. The difference between the two fields, in terms of dealing with immortality, is that religion calls for accessing it in the afterlife, in paradise, while literature focuses on eternity in our worldly lives. For philosophy giants like Aristotle, the universe is eternal in terms of time, but it is finite in terms of spatial extent. Accordingly, the universe has infinite past and future which makes it eternal. Aristotle's thoughts were supported effectively by the Islamic philosopher Averroes, Ibn Rushd, since Aristotle gives eternity to time and mortality to place like the earth and all creatures that will vanish one day.

Immortality in literature can be divided into two quests or types. The first one is eternity through death itself, and the second one is the inaccessible eternity which is immortality and living forever on the earth. The first one is sought by heroes who fight bravely in battles to keep their names memorized as great historical knights through either fulfilling great victories or dying at the battlefields. The second one refers to endless or infinite time along with eternal youth which can be attained through certain materials or medicine like elixir. This idea was sought by various alchemists and scholars.

However, a lot of people had the quest to look for eternal life, and many others have been searching for the secrets that might help them attain immortality during the past centuries. People were eager for such great ambitions but none of them could break up the norms and rules of Almighty Allah Who destined death for all creatures. In the past and present, death was and still is the final destination for all human beings and every creature on this planet.

In literature, immortality was depicted as a significant issue that people have been looking for. It has been highlighted by ancient prominent literary pieces such as ‘The Epic of Gilgamesh’ which dates back to the 22nd century BCE. This is one of the first literary quests toward eternity.

In the meantime, alchemists have been searching for elixir of life to step forward immortality. Although they might feel that they were searching

for the impossible, we appreciate their quest because it features the great vigor and ambition of the former scholars. This scene forms an important part of Medieval literature since literature at that time concentrated on themes of magic and adventure.

As for religion, it calls its followers to attain immortality across this life itself. According to religion, people need to be good human beings who do good deeds and avoid sins. Religion invites its followers to be good citizens in order to serve their societies and countries to set aside a better life for them and the people around them. Through the good deeds, human beings can succeed in this life and obtain an eternal wealthy life in the paradise after death.

Literature dealt with immortality differently since heroes of stories attempted to achieve immortality in this world and on this earth. All their attempts failed and none of them could achieve this target. Throughout such attempts, immortality energized the imagination of writers to write fantastic stories, novels, and poems such as T. S. Eliot's *Whispers of Immortality*, Robert Herrick's *Eternity*, etc.

The three main religions: Islam, Christianity and Judaism concentrate intensively on immortality, and the three religions agree about immortality, but not in this life since immortality can be attained only in the afterlife. The unity and harmony of the three main religions about immortality leads to significant questions especially the question about the existence of the Creator and the afterlife.

These religions have been calling people to work for their afterlife, and they affirmed that immortality is an unattainable target on the earth. They presented a true explanation and a clear message about immortality. Part of this message becomes clearer with the advancement of science and technology since this advancement failed to break up the norms of mortality. This is the answer for the first part of the religious call for immortality which came true, therefore we should think logically about the second part which is immortality in the afterlife, which will certainly come true just like the first one.

The dream of immortality on the earth has been clarified as an unattainable one since nothing on this earth among living creatures survived or can survive forever. All creatures including people, animals, insects, trees, and the other species have a certain lifespan, and they die once they complete their life cycle. Some species or creatures may live longer, but they will face the same destiny as those that lived for a shorter time.

Everything takes us toward the same conclusion which is death. It is waiting for all, and immortality is an inaccessible quest in this world. What we need most is to think about life itself and how to make it more beneficial for us and others.

In the interim, we mustn't ignore immortality, but we need to look for it throughout different ways from the aforementioned heroes. We believe in medical advancement and its positive results, but, at the same time, we mustn't be overoptimistic about any possible extraordinary breakthroughs that may be in the offing.

This helps you access immortality two times: the first one is through immortalizing your name as the other people may remember you for a long time after your death and the second one is the real immortality that you are going to enjoy in the afterlife. Chapter Four

Mortality

Mortality can play a positive role in our lives as it urges us to plan our lives well. It motivates us to be aware of our journey on earth which must come to an end. When we are aware of that, we plan and work accordingly through dedicating every moment in our lives to fulfil further achievements. We also make use of every moment to make either worldly achievements or heavenly ones via noble contributions and good deeds.

All people are sure that they are going to pass away one day, and they are curious to know what happens to them on that day when they abandon life and enter the first stage of the afterlife. We have got some religious information about that, describing how human beings will be after death.

Let's consider this issue logically through assessing the available information about death to help us draw helpful conclusions.

Death is still something vague because we have never ever tried it and no one experienced death and returned to us once again to tell us about its nature and secrets. We have received some religious information about death from the Creator Himself Who created life and death. As for believers, they have no problem with the religious information since they believe in what they have received.

For non-believers, we may ask them to think logically and assess the religious information in general i.e., the information about death, like what we have received in the Holy Qur'an, and information about other different issues. If the information about the other issues is true then the information about death is fully true because we got the information from the same source, the Holy Qur'an, the Book that Almighty Allah has revealed.

According to the Holy Qur'an, there is a similarity between death and sleep. Almighty Allah says in the Holy Qur'an: "Allah takes the souls at the time of their death, and those that do not die [He takes] during their sleep. Then He keeps those for which He has decreed death and releases the others for a specified term. Indeed, in that are signs for a people who give thought" - Az-Zumar, 42. Almighty Allah said in another Sura: "And it is He who takes your souls by night and knows what you have

committed by day. Then He revives you therein that a specified term may be fulfilled. Then to Him will be your return; then He will inform you about what you used to do” - Al-Annam, 60. When we consider the two verses, we can observe the similarity between death and sleep.

When we sleep, we are usually unaware of time and how long time passes from the beginning of our sleep till we get up. If any individual is kept inside a room without providing him with a clock or watch and he can't see anything outside like the sun, then this individual won't be aware of time. If he sleeps and gets up, it is impossible for him to tell us how long he slept because he wasn't aware of time and things that were happening around him. Sleep might last for minutes, hours, or more.

When people die and resurrect again, they will be like that. They won't know how long they stayed in their graves, especially non-believers because they didn't believe in Allah or the afterlife. Believers, at that time, knew that they were dead and resurrected again, but they also don't know how long they stayed in their graves. The Holy Qur'an said about that “And the Day the Hour appears the criminals will swear they had remained but an hour. Thus, they were deluded.” - Art-Room, 55.

According to the verse, non-believers are deluded and can't comprehend what is happening around them because they were like that in their life. They swore that they spent very short time in graves despite the fact they stayed until doomsday. Believers are the opposite, and they are wise as

they were wise in their worldly lives. They even provide a wise answer when they tell non-believers that they had stayed in their graves until doomsday or the Day of Judgement. Believers are aware of that because they were aware of death during their worldly lives and they used to prepare themselves for this journey, the journey of immortality.

The verse includes another indication which resembles death to sleep. When both believers and non-believers resurrect, they are sure that they were in their graves, but both parties don't know how long they remained.

In light of the previous example, if we keep some persons in a room and leave them for a certain period of time without providing them with any device that may tell them about time and then they sleep and get up later on. They will be in a similar situation to that of people in the doomsday. They will be aware of the place, but they will never be aware of time.

Almighty Allah told us in the Holy Qur'an that we are going to die one day in addition to all creatures. We can't deny this because we used to observe that in our daily lives. The question is: if we know that we are going to die and we are proceeding toward our destination with the lapse of each day and get closer to it, then why we attempt to ignore death or not to think about it? Avoiding thinking will never extend our life or make us live longer. On the contrary, it deprives us of many advantages.

Thinking and reading about death make us more logical individuals and provide us with knowledge and information about what will happen to us after death. They also make us better human beings because people who think about death will concentrate on good deeds to protect themselves in both life and afterlife. They also become more beneficial to other people in this worldly life, but in the afterlife, they can do nothing for non-believers because they were destined to be dwellers of hell.

Let's consider death from a different angle which is the scientific one. According to science and some relevant studies, death occurs when the heart stops beating followed by halt of the functions of the other organs of the body. The other organs start stopping from work since they don't receive the required blood supply which empowers them to function and sustain the cells of the various organs such as the brain.

Meanwhile, several scientific studies have documented brain activity occurring even after death. Although these activities are brief, they suggest that something continues to happen to living beings after death. This could mark the beginning of an afterlife which is different from our current existence. This new phase of life may be either enjoyable or agonizing.

Accordingly, the union of body and soul occurs in two stages amid our journey toward immortality. The first one occurs between birth and death. In the second stage of the journey, we experience separation between the

body and the soul during which our bodies will be disintegrated while our souls will be kept in a certain space till the start of the third stage. The third and the last stage starts with resurrection in which our bodies and souls reunite again exactly like the union of our bodies and souls of the first stage. Hence, immortality journey starts with an eternal happy life or an eternal miserable life.

As for immortality on the earth, Think Logically asserts that immortality on the earth is impossible. Sometimes, the number of certain creatures increases rapidly in a way that endangers nature, environment or other creatures, then we have certain disasters such as pandemics, volcanoes, earthquakes, or fires which contribute to restoring the balance once again. This is similar to the dinosaurs' era, when they ruled vast part of the earth. How did that era end? It ended with an epic asteroid wherein that catastrophe reorganized the planet in a new way and shifted sovereignty to different species.

The giant asteroid that ended the dinosaurs' era is also considered as one of the most catastrophic events that the earth has ever undergone. The asteroid caused extinction of a lot of species including animals and plants and marked the beginning of a new era on the earth. Although this event caused a huge destruction, it also contributed to reorganizing the earth in a way that might fit new creatures better. Consequently, mortality has been playing a great role in balancing the planet through ending the lives of certain creatures to pave the way for new ones.

While discussing mortality and its impact on people, a different impact can be observed on believers and non-believers. The difference here is associated with anxiety. When death comes to the minds of believers, they

think positively about it and think about what they did for the day of death. They don't feel afraid of it, and if they had committed mistakes and sins, they would attempt to atone for their guilts and sins.

For non-believers, they try either to avoid thinking about death or think negatively since they did nothing for that day. They feel scared, because they think that they are going to embark on a perilous damned journey into the unknown.

They feel, at their last moments, that they missed everything as they didn't grab the opportunity when they had it. They lived for a long time, but they didn't prepare or get ready for this inescapable journey. They also feel sorry because they didn't think logically or neutrally about the various stages of their life. At that time, they realize the significance of this stage, and they feel sorry for it, but sorrow is worthless because the test has been completed, and the scores would be disclosed at the last moment of life.

As for believers, they sometimes miss death and wish to be closer to it because they believe that death is the first step toward the heavens and immortality. They even enjoy thinking or working for that stage unlike non-believers. For believers, the sole thing that separates them from the heavens is death and waiting for the end of their lives which will open the door toward eternity.

Believers believe that death will be a new beginning as they believe that people who pass away will be in an intermediary state. This state is between life and afterlife, and they maintain the same state until resurrection for the Day of Judgement.

Accordingly, death isn't the end at all, on the contrary, it is the beginning of a new promising stage. It is just the end of our worldly life on this planet. This stage includes separation between the body and the soul which represents a new journey in a new blessed world.

We are sure that all human beings live on this earth and die on it, but we need to think logically about what is beyond death and how we will rise once again. According to various scientific studies there are some viable cells in the human body, and those cells might be the base for our resurrection at a certain time. All people, on doomsday, will resurrect again and get ready for the Day of Judgement in which they will be granted a happy eternal life or a miserable eternal one.

At that time, all people made sure that they were in a test in which they would be either winners or losers as some of them would pass the test and others would fail. The people who successfully pass the test will enjoy a great immortal life in heavens. In the final stage, some people will also be busy with the great paradise and the wealthy life and property that Almighty Allah will grant. The other people will be also busy with indescribable eternal sadness and misery, and they will never ever be allowed to get out of this miserable situation.

Almighty Allah can force us to believe by sending down a great sign that may endanger the lives of non-believers or attract their attention in different ways. Almighty Allah said in the Holy Qur'an "If We willed, We could send down to them from the sky a sign for which their necks would remain humbled"- Ash-Shu'araa, 4.

The verse is clear. Almighty Allah gave options to all people after sending down certain signs which are very clear for those who think logically about them. Meanwhile, these clear signs will remain vague for those who prefer to freeze or restrict role of their minds through avoiding considering the Creator's signs.

When Almighty Allah created Adam, who was tempted by Satan, He ordered both to get down to the earth. Allah also destined that a lot of people and devil would be the dwellers of hell. Those who follow the divine instructions and believe in Almighty Allah will be saved to enjoy eternal life in the first place that Adam had dwelt before the earth. Those who follow the devil will be the dwellers of hell and share eternal suffering with devil.

Let's consider another real-life example. As a university professor, when you want to assess your students' performance, there are key steps to follow. First, you need to determine how to conduct the assessment, including the number and type of questions. Imagine if you created a test but provided your students with almost all the answers beforehand. This would undermine the value of the test, rendering it meaningless. Students might conclude that the test is unimportant, leading them to regret the time they invested in studying.

Thus, if the test is very clear and the answers are almost provided to students then how the tester will differentiate between tested persons! If we have clear answers to the questions, then there is no need for the test itself. As a result, if people see clearer signs, then there will be no option for them, and everyone must believe forcibly.

A former secular co-worker of mine said, why I can't see Almighty Allah! I need to see Him in order to believe! This is the question of a former co-worker and other people might have similar questions. Let's consider this issue logically as per the previous test example and explore how non-seeing Almighty Allah is part of the test.

Before answering the question, we need to clarify something. We must know that Almighty Allah doesn't need our belief and worship. He revealed certain instructions for people and gave them the option to believe or disbelieve. Therefore, during life, some of them succeed and

others fail. The first thing that we need to be aware of is that our belief will never ever benefit Almighty Allah.

To illustrate this more, we need to consider modern science products. This can be trusted easily because all people live on the earth and the whole earth is worthless when compared to the huge universe. If we think logically about how weak we are, we can notice our weakness and fallibility through everything around us.

Despite all scientific advancement and development of technology, we could discover only mini part of the universe. Some experts said that we didn't discover more than 1 percent of our huge universe, if the universe is as big as they expected. They also said that it might be much bigger than what they had expected. How the great God Who created all that needs us or needs our worship and how we will see Him on the earth! Of course, He can allow us to see Him, but this will never happen now because non-seeing Him allows the test to proceed smoothly.

Think logically about who needs the other! Do people need Almighty Allah or Almighty Allah needs people? For believers the answer is well known and for non-believers it may vary from one to another. Anyway, believers know the right path which they are going through while non-believers are perplexed for a very simple reason which is the lack of logical and neutral thinking.

When people don't think logically, they deprive themselves of a golden opportunity to discover the truth. Almighty Allah created us with minds to think well and meditate about our creation and everything around us. If we restrict the role of our minds, we will miss the right path.

Every normal person can discover the truth if this person thinks about the signs that Almighty Allah sent down. Therefore, Almighty Allah differentiated people from other creatures by granting them the mind and the ability to think. If we freeze the role of mind, we will narrow the difference between us and the other creatures.

Back to considering the question of the secular co-worker about seeing the Creator. In this life, people can't see Almighty Allah and He said something about that in the Holy Qur'an. He said that people can't see Him and He sees everything. "Vision perceives Him not, but He perceives [all] vision; and He is the Subtle, the Acquainted"- Al-An'aam", 103.

Instead of seeing the Creator, the co-worker, and everyone who has similar questions, can scrutinize the signs around them to discover the truth by themselves. He provided us with clear signs to hold us responsible for all our actions in this life. When He said this is My creation, we need to consider this well and think logically about it. When we think logically our thinking and mind will lead us to the right path.

The other thing is that Almighty Allah revealed certain instructions to differentiate between people who believe and people who don't believe.

He also told us that we will see Him in the afterlife, but in our worldly life this will never happen. Here lies the answer to the question of the secular co-worker.

He told us that we can't see Him only in this life, but at the same time He gave us too many signs to know Him through. Further, if seeing Almighty Allah is impossible now, it will be possible in the afterlife. This will be possible for believers only while non-believers will never ever see Him neither in this life nor in the afterlife as mentioned in the Holy Qur'an.

Almighty Allah mentioned these two cases in the Holy Qur'an, saying that believers will see Him with a great happiness. "[Some] faces, that Day, will be radiant. Looking at their Lord" - Al-Qiyaama, 22/23. He also said non-believers will never see Him, and they will be deprived of this great bliss as this bliss is described as the best one that the dwellers of the heavens can have. "No! Indeed, from their Lord, that Day, they will be partitioned" - Al-Mutaffifin, 15. If seeing Almighty Allah is the best bliss for believers, consequently depriving non-believers from this bliss will be the biggest loss.

Now, everything is clear after providing clear signs and calling people to consider them and then people can decide whether to believe or not. The message here is clear for non-believers as it tells them that they have full freedom and options to choose the way they like. They can choose the right path or the wrong one. It is up to them.

I would like to tell the former secular co-worker that non-seeing the Creator is part of the test that people undergo in this life and on this earth. Therefore, you will never see Him, but you can feel His presence throughout the signs that he created on this earth, in the universe and in yourself. Consider that logically and then make up your mind. If you really think logically and neutrally you will succeed and if you make a prior decision before even thinking you will be one of the biggest losers. I wish you and all people a lucky choice.

Chapter Six

Are there Real Scriptures?

Books are generally expected to improve people's lives and broaden their awareness in different fields. They often offer knowledge in areas like literature, history, morality, religion, commerce, finance, business, psychology, spirituality etc., while people's interests also differ, with some focusing on scientific and technological texts and others are drawn to literary works like novels, plays, and poems.

The human interest in these books varies according to some factors such as content that may draw the reader's attention. The variety of tastes and interests unveils human diversity since people have different interests, inclinations and preferences. Each one reads the books he/she likes and between the covers of each book lies some points that attract certain people and make them eager to read.

Amongst these types of books, there is one type described as holy or sacred. Hence, readers may inquire about the reality of these holy books or scriptures and how they can make sure whether these books are holy or not. While considering this issue, readers need to identify the meaning of the word holy first. The term "HOLY" signifies something sacred, highly revered, or respected by people.

According to the Merriam-Webster online dictionary, “HOLY” is defined as “exalted or worthy of complete devotion as one perfect in goodness and righteousness”. The word is often used to describe important things such as religious texts or cities. When something is labeled as holy, it holds great significance, at least, for a certain group or groups of people, regardless of whether others consider it sacred or not.

In general, when referring to a book as holy, it is typically associated with Almighty Allah. A large portion of people worldwide, particularly the followers of the three major religions Islam, Christianity, and Judaism believe in the existence of holy books and scriptures. They believe that Allah conveyed His guidance to His prophets through these holy scriptures, consequently believers of these three faiths accept the concept of divine revelation through holy books. The followers of three religions have no problem about being holy as they consider their books as holy ones.

It addresses various issues to demonstrate how a text can be considered holy from the perspectives of science, reality, and history. Its primary objective is to encourage readers to recognize certain facts, help them to better assess religious texts and differentiate between what is sacred and what pertains to everyday life.

People call some books “holy” because the books are believed to contain divine or sacred wisdom, guidance, or revelations from a superpower. These texts are typically central to a religious tradition and considered instructive in matters of faith, morality, and spiritual practice. They are expected to contribute to improving the lives of people in the past, present, and future in addition to enhancing social reform because their ultimate objective is to help people build good societies that cooperate with each other. These books also focus intensively on building families since the family is the cornerstone of society and building good families often leads to building good societies.

As for divine revelation, many religious traditions believe that holy books were either directly revealed by God or written or narrated by prophets and enlightened the people who accept their instructions. Muslims, for

example, believe that the Holy Qur'an is the literal word of Allah as revealed to Prophet Mohammad, peace be upon him, while Christians view the Bible as inspired by God through human authors.

However, holy books are distinguished with certain characteristics such as spiritual guidance and often provide moral teachings, ethical guidelines, and spiritual practices that followers are encouraged to adhere to in order to live a righteous and fulfilling life. They also have a historical significance as they often contain the historical narrative of a religion, including the lives of prophets, and key figures, making them vital to the identity and continuity of the religious tradition.

A holy book often symbolizes the relationship between humans and the divine. It is more than just a book; it's seen as a stream of divine presence and wisdom; therefore, these books have symbolic values as well. They also organize the relationship between believers and Allah as Creator and created or God and worshipers. The created ones are the weaker party that need to be obedient to the powerful party Who created them. This reality enhances belief of religion followers and makes them more respectful, thankful, and obedient to their sole Creator. These texts are also considered holy because of their profound influence on the spiritual lives of those who follow the respective religion.

Authenticity of revelation is another significant characteristic. Interested readers can follow certain steps to test revelation and make sure whether

it has been revealed by God or whether this text is mere words written by people. For followers of religions, holy books or scriptures are believed to have been revealed by God to a prophet. In the meantime, the life, character, and miraculous acts of the prophet like Christ, peace be upon him, are often viewed as evidence of the divine nature of the revelation.

The scriptures, with the lapse of time, gain historical authenticity and reliability in addition to the time period when the revelation occurred which can also be considered as evidence. These things include the consistency of the prophet's message, and their impact on the community.

Over time, scriptures can either retain their sacredness or lose it, depending on their consistency and accuracy. If the text is free from errors or contradictions, it will remain sacred; if it contains inconsistencies or false information, its sacredness will be called into question. This distinction stems from the belief that while human beings are fallible, the supreme power, in this case, Allah, is infallible or absolutely right. If a scripture is written solely by humans without divine revelation, then any discovered contradictions or inaccuracies would undermine its authority. However, if the scripture is revealed by Allah, it will always be free from contradictions and falsehoods.

Internal consistency and teachings include coherence and unity as believers often point to the internal consistency of the holy book over time as a sign of divine origin. A book that is believed to be divinely revealed

is expected to have a coherent message, even if it spans many years and addresses different contexts.

Further, moral and spiritual teachings are examined as many people judge the divine origin of a holy book based on the depth, wisdom, and universality of its teachings. If the guidance it provides has transformative power and leads to higher moral or spiritual development, this can be taken as a sign of its divine source.

The other thing is miraculous elements that can be tracked down in the scriptures wherein some traditions believe that miracles are associated with the revelation including the prophet's ability to convey deep truths or even predictions about future events in a way that confirms its divine origin.

Inimitability is another key feature as some scriptures are believed to be inimitable which means that their literary style or message cannot be replicated by human beings because the scripture includes certain clues that fall behind the ability or comprehension of human beings. Sometimes such things sound possible, but when people try, they fail to replicate.

The Qur'an, for instance, is deemed to be a linguistic and literary miracle that cannot be imitated by any human effort, a proof of its divine origin. If any professional person in Arabic reads some verses of the Holy

Qur'an, this reader will make sure immediately that people can't replicate what is there in terms of language and style.

The Holy Qur'an includes great narratives about the past, and future with amazing stories on multiple civilizations and figures. This diversity in providing information and being precise without any faults ensures that this holy book is the literal word of Almighty Allah and a reliable divine revelation.

Some readers consider historical evidence to assess a holy book's connection to God by checking its historical accuracy. If the events or prophecies mentioned in the scripture aligned with known historical facts or were fulfilled, this is seen as evidence. When people observe some prophecies come true, this strengthens their belief and clears all doubts about the scripture because of the historical evidence which is a reliable tool for many readers.

The way a holy book influences the lives of its followers inspires goodness, compassion, and a sense of divine presence can also be viewed as evidence of its divine source. For believers, this issue is unquestionable as they believe in holy books, while observing new evidence can increase their faith and belief.

The case is different with non-believers because they don't believe in the holy books. What non-believers need here is just to review, read, and

Chapter Eight

Morality

According to some moral arguments, the existence of objective moral values is best illustrated by the existence of a moral legislator, often identified as God. This argument concentrates on several main concepts such as the nature of morality, the distinction between objective and subjective moral values, and the implications of a moral legislator for understanding ethics in addition to the human behavior which also indicates that the similarities between such behaviors affirm the idea of one Creator.

On the one hand, objective moral values theorize the existence of universal moral truths. These truths aren't connected with personal opinions or cultural contexts. On the other hand, subjective moral values insist that moral judgments are conditional to individual perspectives, social values, and cultural norms.

The objective moral values are deemed to be principles transcending individual life and cultural norms as they are binding and universal. Some concepts can be taken as examples like the concept 'murder is wrong' or 'helping needy people is good'. These concepts are often perceived as moral principles.

This is applicable even in diverse societies with varying beliefs, since there is a recurring agreement on certain primary moral truths, confirming objective morality. The objective values are common characteristics or principles that people enjoy. When a big number of people embrace the same values, then this issue asserts the existence of one Creator Who created all people and provided them with these good values.

In contrast, subjective moral values assert that moral values are determined by personal feelings, social norms, or cultural influences. This perspective unveils that what is “right” or “wrong” can vary from one person or culture to another. If morality were purely subjective, it would be challenging to argue against practices that most would find objectionable, such as slavery or genocide, as these could be justified by cultural context or individual preferences. These values differ as per the individuals or social perspectives and how each society or individual views the values.

The moral argument advocates assert that the existence of objective moral values demands a source beyond human control. This source is often understood as a moral legislator, typically identified as God. Such an assertion implies that objective moral values are grounded in a main standard to which all humans can appeal. It also indicates that all human beings are created by one Creator, Almighty Allah.

However, objective and subjective values exist among people. Objective values refer to the common values that people share regardless of their country, citizenship, society, or environment. Sometimes, environment affects people and contributes to modifying some values or creating new ones, either positive or negative, due to certain factors and practices, forming some subjective values.

This is a step toward creating subjective values which doesn't refute the existence of one Creator because people can influence each other, and environment can influence people as well. The very people who developed subjective values still enjoy many objective values which sound innate and are born with people from their early days in this life.

Amongst the strongest facts of the moral argument is the acknowledgement that moral values function similarly to laws in a society. It is like human laws that require a legislator, moral laws require a moral legislator as well. If objective moral values exist, then there must be an ultimate source, transcending human experience and providing a basis for these values.

The notion that God exists as a moral legislator refers that God calls for the good of mankind and that moral laws are reflections of His power. This points out that actions are deemed good or bad not arbitrarily, but in accordance with divine standards. This view is conveyed in various religious traditions and through the behaviors of people as well.

God's commands align with the objective moral values because such commands aim to improve the behavior of people. For instance, if God commands to respect our neighbors, then this command reflects an inherent goodness amongst human beings, and this goodness can be increased or decreased by the people's practices. Goodness and good manners can be maintained, increased or decreased according to people's interest and whether they like to be good human beings or not because each person is responsible for his/her good or bad behaviors.

Morality refers to another thing which is moral accountability. If moral values are objective and developed from a divine source, then this indicates that individuals are accountable for their actions. This accountability raises a sense of responsibility and ethical obligation inside communities, supporting the importance of adhering to moral laws. In the past, Arabs were very proud of their linguistic excellence and narrating poetry. The Arabian Peninsula and the other Arab regions included a huge number of amazing poets. Arabs also used to highly respect both poets and knights to the extent that Arabian kings used to avoid annoying or angering poets. In fact, kings were afraid of the tongues of poets not afraid of their power or swords because kings were sure if a good poet satirizes them then this satire will be memorized and narrated by Arabs till the end of life.

Poets and knights also occupied a prominent rank in Arabic culture and literature. The poets were esteemed for their great poetic skills, and the knights were esteemed for their chivalry, swords, and the role they played in protecting their tribes or nations. For a lot of Arabs, the man could be perfect if he mastered two things: poetry and chivalry.

Arabs, in general, paid a great attention to language, not only poets, and they were meticulous in terms of choosing words either in their literary symposiums and meetings or even in their ordinary lives. Poetry, oratory, and eloquence were part of their lives. Therefore, the role of poetry in Arabic language is similar to the role of theatre in English literature.

Accordingly, we can call Arabic Language as the language of poetry and English language as the language of theatre especially in the past as novel overwhelmed drama in English literature within the last two centuries.

Poetry played another great role in the lives of Arabs as it contributed to uniting them against certain dangers. It united Arabs against the Sassanid Empire, Persians, in Dhi Qar Battle and they won a great victory. Poetry also contributed to documenting history of their nation, victories, and many other occasions like the poem of Al-A'sha which described the details of Dhi Qar battle and how Arabs won that great victory.

During this golden era of Arabic language, Almighty Allah revealed the Holy Qur'an to challenge the Arabs in the field where they excelled. When Arabs heard some verses of the Holy Qur'an, they were astonished, awe-struck and admired what they had heard and got sure, from the very beginning, that such words can't be said or composed by human beings. They believed that it couldn't be, but a divine diction and it would never ever be a human composition. They had never ever heard anything like that.

At that time, Arabs in Mecca were divided into two groups. Some of them believed in Almighty Allah as the sole Creator and the other group got convinced that the Holy Qur'an was revealed by Almighty Allah, but they didn't believe that He is the sole God. Although they thought that Almighty Allah is the one Who created the earth and the universe, they

didn't believe as they worshipped different fetishes. The worship of the other fetishes spoiled their belief.

Due to Arabs' linguistic excellence, they acknowledged that the Holy Qur'an was far more sublime than the Arabic poetry, prose, and stories. Furthermore, the Holy Qur'an challenged all Arabs, the masters of poetry, eloquence, and oratory to bring a few verses like that of the Holy Qur'an. "Say, If mankind and the jinn gathered in order to produce the like of this Qur'an, they could not produce the like of it, even if they were to each other assistants" - Al-Israa, 88. "Or do they say [about the Prophet], "He invented it?" Say, "Then bring forth a surah like it and call upon [for assistance] whomever you can besides Allah, if you should be truthful" - Yunus, 38.

After challenging Arabs to come up with a few verses similar to that of the Holy Qur'an, Almighty Allah said that He revealed the Holy Qur'an, His great book. He also promised to preserve the Holy Qur'an forever against any changes or modifications. No one in the past could change a single word and no one in the future will be capable of changing a single word. Therefore, we have the same Holy Qur'an from 1400 years until now and it will continue like this forever. Almighty Allah said "Indeed, it is We who sent down the Qur'an and indeed, We will be its guardian - Al-Hijr, 9.

When Almighty Allah revealed the Holy Qur'an and promised to preserve it up forever, He added one more important thing to clear all doubts about the Holy Qur'an. Some non-believers may say that the Holy Qur'an is revealed by Almighty Allah, but Prophet Mohammad, peace be upon him, might change some verses. Almighty Allah said in the Holy Qur'an about this issue: "Nor does he speak from [his own] inclination. It is not but a revelation revealed" - An-Najm, 3/4. The previous verses certify that the Holy Qur'an was revealed by Almighty Allah and Almighty Allah will preserve and protect it forever.

The Holy Qur'an isn't a mere masterpiece that includes great divine instructions, it is also a great book that includes laws for organizing life, miscellaneous information about different fields such medicine, policy, history, etc. It is also a great literary masterpiece with wonderful eloquence, style, expressions, and many other features and characteristics like narrating stories from the past.

The Holy Qur'an contributed to adding great features to Arabic language especially maintaining the language with the lapse of time, enriching it, and polishing its grammar. With a brief comparison between Arabic and any other language, it will be clear that the other language has undergone numerous changes during its history while Arabic is still the same in terms

of grammar, spelling, and sentence structure even after inserting more derivations or words into Arabic.

We can have a clear example about that when we ask a native reader of Arabic to read an old text written a thousand years ago. The reader will understand the text well. In the meantime, if we ask another native reader to read a text, from his/her language, written a thousand years ago, the reader may misunderstand part of the text and in some languages the reader may misunderstand most of the text. This is because the other languages keep changing continuously while Arabic language is preserved by the Holy Qur'an and kept up its grammar even after deriving new words to match the modern life.

The Holy Qur'an calls all human beings to read and think about it to discover by themselves whether this Holy Book is revealed by Almighty Allah or composed by human beings. The Holy Qur'an calls for that because it is a perfect and wise book, and no one can find contradictions between its multiple verses because it is revealed by Almighty Allah. "Then do they not reflect upon the Qur'an? If it had been from [any] other than Allah, they would have found within it much contradiction" - An-Nisaa, 82.

The Holy Qur'an deals with various aspects of life including the scientific ones. It highlighted certain norms that modern science couldn't break up, and it will never break up till the end of life. Such norms include the soul and immortality which have been illustrated in two chapters of this book.

The modern science along with its great advancement couldn't provide us with any clear information about the soul. It also couldn't help people step forward immortality on the earth. Science failed in these fields because Almighty Allah destined death to all creatures and kept some important information for Himself such as the information about the soul and the time of the doomsday which is concealed from angels, mankind, and all creatures. Almighty Allah said "And they ask you, [O Muhammad], about the soul. Say, "The soul is of the affair of my Lord. And mankind have not been given of knowledge except a little" - Al-Israa, 85.

Since the revelation of the Holy Qur'an, people have been discovering new scientific clues in it. Some of these clues are proven by science recently, more specifically during the last century. In the Holy Qur'an, there is a verse indicates that Almighty Allah created the universe, and He expands it more and more.

According to science, the universe expands continuously. Such a fact can't be proven only by having very developed devices like giant

telescopes. In the past, this idea couldn't be validated due to the lack of the required technology, and the Holy Qur'an stated that before having technology and before the development of science. "And the heaven We constructed with strength, and indeed, We are [its] expander"- Adh-Dhaariyat, 47.

Along with the advancement of science, we can have a clearer view of the great creation of our Creator. The new technology empowered us to discover accurate information about human body, human life, the universe, stars, the earth, and space. All these discoveries tell us that there is Almighty Creator. In the Holy Qur'an Almighty Allah says, "We will show them Our signs in the horizons and within themselves until it becomes clear to them that it is the truth. But is it not sufficient concerning your Lord that He is, over all things, a Witness?"- Fussilat, 53.

With logical thinking, we realize that our lives are nothing when compared to the afterlife. This worldly life won't last long, and it will come to an end one day, but the afterlife is eternal. Therefore, there is no comparison between worldly life and the eternal one which is full of happiness and joy unlike our worldly lives that must undergo troubles and turbulence. Allah says "And this worldly life is not but diversion and amusement. And indeed, the home of the Hereafter - that is the [eternal] life, if only they knew" - Al-Ankaboot, 64.

In addition to the excerpts that we went through, there are more scientific signs describing various phenomena in the Holy Qur'an. In the past, before people travel by planes, they had no idea about how oxygen decreases with higher altitudes. When human beings are at high altitudes, they feel that they are out of breath or breathe hard because the oxygen and air pressure decrease and if they get higher then pressure will decrease more and more. With elevations or altitudes, the body obtains less oxygen than that on the earth or lower altitudes because there is less oxygen in that area. This issue has been highlighted by the Holy Qur'an when Almighty Allah gave an example about people who don't believe in Him.

According to the verse, people who don't believe in Allah feel as if they were under continuous pressure unlike believers who feel relieved and relaxed because of Almighty Allah's guidance and help. "So whoever Allah wants to guide - He expands his breast to [contain] Islam; and whoever He wants to misguide - He makes his breast tight and constricted as though he were climbing into the sky. Thus does Allah place defilement upon those who do not believe"-Al-An'aam, 125.

According to various scientific studies, the mountains play a significant role in fixing the earth. The mountains are like great pegs that fix the earth similar to the role of pegs that we usually use to raise and fix tents.

Consequently, the mountains contribute to maintaining the motion of the earth to remain in the same orbit and continue the same way of its movement. “Have We not made the earth a resting place? And the mountains as stakes?”- Al-Naba, 6/7. “And you see the mountains, thinking them rigid, while they will pass as the passing of clouds. [It is] the work of Allah, who perfected all things. Indeed, He is Acquainted with that which you do” - An-Naml, 88.

One more thing, modern science revealed that seas and oceans’ waters don’t mix when they meet with each other. The scientific studies gave an explanation to that which is related to the different salinity and density of the waters. These two factors formed something similar to a thin wall that prevents waters from mixing with each other. The matter is highlighted in the Holy Qur’an when Almighty Allah said, “He released the two seas, meeting [side by side]; Between them is a barrier [so] neither of them transgresses” - Ar-Rahmaan, 19/20.

Such clues and information were revealed and written in the Holy Qur’an 14 centuries ago, and now modern science validates them. I may question now: who told Prophet Mohammad, peace be upon him, that? Anyway, this is part of a wider range of scientific, literary, medical, legal, political, and other information available in the Holy Qur’an. If Mohammad wasn’t a Prophet, then he would never be able to provide such information!

Secondly, if he is a prophet then this means that he got the information from Almighty Allah Who knows everything.

Having multiple examples and clues in the Holy Qur'an is another evidence. When we have multiple examples and clues, this also means that nothing happened accidentally. On the contrary, everything is organized, and it functions according to precise laws. If there is only one example or a few examples, some people may say that this occurred by chance or accidentally since we sometimes expect something, and it occurs as we expect, but when we have multiple expectations some of them fail and some of them may come true.

Let's consider a real-life example. When you expect a student to pass a test, expecting him/her to get 90 out of 100, your expectation may come true. But if you expect 10 students to pass the test along with guessing a specific mark for each one, your expectations won't come true. A few expectations may come true, but it is impossible for all of them to come true. Therefore, the multiples examples and clues in the Holy Qur'an form solid evidence that this great book is revealed by Almighty Allah.

Following the previous examples and clues, let us consider a very short story in the Holy Qur'an about resurrecting the dead. In this Qur'anic short story, a non-believer came to Prophet Mohammad, peace be upon

him, holding a disintegrated bone. The non-believer said to Prophet: do you claim that Allah will give life to this disintegrated bone once again? Prophet said: yes, Allah gives you life again after your death and casts you in the hell. The Holy Qur'an narrated this story with providing examples on how Almighty Allah gives life to creatures after their death.

“And he presents for Us an example and forgets his [own] creation. He says, “Who will give life to bones while they are disintegrated?” Say, “He will give them life who produced them the first time; and He is, of all creation, Knowing.” [It is] He who made for you from the green tree, fire, and then from it you ignite. Is not He who created the heavens and the earth Able to create the likes of them? Yes, [it is so]; and He is the Knowing Creator. His command is only when He intends a thing that He says to it, “Be,” and it is. So exalted is He in whose hand is the realm of all things, and to Him you will be returned” - Yaseen, 78-83.

Almighty Allah promised the righteous people great rewards in the afterlife. These rewards are better than any other rewards because they last forever in the heavens. This also comprises a call for all people to choose logically because if they miss the heavens then they will be amongst the dwellers of hell. Almighty Allah said, “Say, Is that better or the Garden of Eternity which is promised to the righteous? It will be for them a reward and destination. For them therein is whatever they wish,

[while] abiding eternally. It is ever upon your Lord a promise [worthy to be] requested”- Al-Furqaan, 15/16.

After giving miscellaneous clear examples: is it logical to think that the universe was found accidentally? Isn't the Holy Qur'an revealed by Almighty Allah? Such great and creative universe is the best evidence for the existence of our great Lord Who created everything and created us. He gave us life, and he will give us life once again after our death, when we resurrect for the Day of Judgement.

Conclusion

Mind and thinking are the things that differentiate people from the other creatures. People use their minds and cleverness to improve the quality of their life and make it easier through working hard to come up with new techniques or inventions that help them meet the requirements of modern life and the advancement of technology.

During this busy modern life, some people may not even have time to think about their destiny. They are too busy with following up their business, work and duties. Consequently, their attention was distracted from essential issues concerning existence in this life and the afterlife. This busy life has full control over their thinking, and some people prioritized businesses to everything else as if they were destined to live forever.

In the meantime, many other people demonstrate more logical tendencies as they think about both worldly life and the afterlife. They meditate on what is going to happen to them at the end of this life and beyond. Meditation is the main idea of this book as it concentrates on calling all people to think logically. It also attempts to draw attention of people to significant issues especially immortal happiness in the afterlife, urging all to have more good deeds since these good deeds will be the best credit and companion after death.

The book presents various real-life examples, facts and excerpts from the Holy Qur'an to prove the presence of a supreme Creator Who created the whole universe. It harnesses such examples to prove that the universe can't be found accidentally as some people believe. The book intentionally uses very simple and unarguable examples, from our daily lives, to bridge all gaps that non-believers exploit while justifying or defending their conceptions.

Bridging the gaps means the logical use of unarguable instances to confirm all facts the book employs. This technique also aims to remind the readers of occurrences that they usually see or practise in their daily lives. However, non-believers and sceptics can't refute the examples used, unless they speak illogically, because they are part and parcel of our life.

After that, the book asks readers to think logically and neutrally about the wonderful design of the universe which looks like a great painting that fascinates the eyes and minds of all human beings. Can this creative image of the universe be found without a supreme painter or creator? Absolutely no, and nothing else can be found without a creator!

When we think logically about the incredible design of our planet and what it contains such as rivers, seas, oceans, forests, mountains, and deserts in addition to the whole universe, we get sure that such a systemized universe can't be found by chance. We need just to consider

that well to understand the philosophy of life which tells us that life emerges from seeds or other sources, and it can't emerge out of nothing.

As for the cited verses from the Holy Qur'an, I didn't intervene in translation of the Qur'anic verses from Arabic into English. I didn't change a single word. I cited all verses from the electronic copy of the Holy Qur'an that was translated and published by King Fahd Complex for the Printing of the Holy Qur'an. This version is also accessible to all on the website of the institution.

The excerpts that I cited from the Holy Qur'an emphasize that these verses can't be composed by people and the whole humanity can't come up with a few verses like them. Thus, the Holy Qur'an must be the Book of Almighty Creator. And if we believe now that there is Almighty Creator for this universe, then we must believe in the second part which is the afterlife because the Creator Himself told us that through the Holy Qur'an.

I would also like to draw the attention of readers to one more significant issue. While writing some examples of this book, I felt that they were a bit tough, but this is the reality, and we have to accept it willy-nilly. I mean, here, the examples about death along with the frequent use of this word. I believe when we face something tough and deal with it wisely and smoothly, this thing will boost our experience, and it might provide us with different advantages. This is because we still have time, and the test

hasn't finished yet. We are still able to change our answers and follow the right path as long as the test is there.

It is well known that a lot of people don't like to read or discuss death-related issues. But if we like that or not, the result is the same. The result is the reality which tells us that we are proceeding throughout our life journey toward a predetermined destination.

Further, thinking about death can lead to positive results as it urges us to think logically and think for solutions to get ready for the next stage by enhancing our belief and increasing good deeds. When we assess the issue of discussing death and obtaining more information about it, we may get sure that its advantages outnumber its disadvantages.

Let's consider one more example which might not be welcomed by some people. Imagine that you passed away and resurrected once again, what will your reaction be? If you believe in Almighty Allah during your life, you will be pleased and feel comfortable for what you have done before. If you didn't believe ... you would be sorry for that and you would never have a chance to change. I hope everyone understands this message because he/she is going to experience that one day and remember the opportunities that he/she missed during the life.

Some people may say, if we die and don't resurrect or died and resurrected once again, but we found nothing like what is mentioned in this book, then we will be losers, too. Let's think logically about this point. If this really

occurs, it will be associated with certain losses, but we need also to compare them with the losses when this comes true after death.

While assessing wins and losses, the loss of the first party, non-believers, will be much worse than the second party, believers. This is because the first party will lose immortal happiness which will be gained by the second party. The loss of the second party won't be a critical one because they missed rewards for some work that they had performed during their worldly lives. Yet the good deeds and things that they performed during their lives benefited them first and other people around them second. Therefore, they didn't experience a great loss like that of the first party.

Let's go deeper through assessing the wins and losses. Remember that it will be an everlasting win or an everlasting loss. During this life you don't need to perform very difficult tasks or work to get rewarded in the afterlife. On the contrary, there are only tolerable tasks. When Almighty Allah calls you to pray this doesn't mean that you keep praying the whole day. All prayers can be performed in a short time when compared to the 24-hour day and night.

Furthermore, all the other requirements are tolerable and if you really can't do any of them, you will be excused. If you don't have money, you don't need to pay alms (Zakat). If you don't have money or physical ability, you don't need to perform pilgrimage (Haj). If fasting is difficult for you because of a certain illness, then you can have solutions for that.

In the meantime, when you perform these rituals, you will benefit from them in this life through either improving your health or helping others and the big win is waiting for you in the afterlife. Are these things difficult? And what is the reward if you do these things? The reward is indescribable! It is an eternal or endless reward. Is this better or damnation? If you prefer damnation, then you must get ready for eternal loss and misery.

Based on this, we need to think logically about the word immortality. This is a very important issue because we aren't talking about a temporary thing or a thing that can be changed! We are talking about eternal life which you are writing its story right now. At the end of your story, you will move either to endless happiness or endless sadness.

Additionally, religion and belief have many more advantages for our lives. They instill in us great values and call us to commit to especially cooperation, tolerance, helping the needy ones and loving each other. In fact, a religion or belief that calls for such great values is meritorious and deserves respect and glorification. Religion and belief also tell us that life can be enjoyable, and we can enjoy ourselves and help others enjoy life in the right way. These two beacons urge us to respect others, preserve their rights and avoid any type of trespass against laws and traditions.

Think Logically also tracks the roots of various issues such as the causes of life and lays out recommendations to help people become aware of their

short lives and how to succeed in the worldly life and the afterlife. The book attempts to enhance satisfaction amongst people and shows that happiness is attainable for everyone. For those who don't have much money, they may enjoy many other things which might be more important than money such as physical health and logical thinking. If they are satisfied, then this will be great bliss to enjoy because satisfaction is the secret behind happiness. It is the best way to overcome negative qualities like envy and miserliness and satisfaction bridges the gap between the haves and the have-nots as well.

Since the book has been prepared as advice to friends and all people, I would like to remind them that good people always like for their friends what they like for themselves. Wise individuals also wish to lead a happy life and wish other people around them to live happily because no one can live happily amongst unhappy or miserable people. Environment always influences individuals and contributes to either increasing or decreasing their happiness.

Let's navigate further with our real examples. Imagine that you are reading this book on the last day of your life, and you are going to bid farewell to this world today. Will your choice be like your choice when you hope to live for years? Absolutely not, because your decisions now are affected by the hope of living for a long time which also influences the way of thinking.

If you know that this is the last day for you in this world, you will think logically because you don't have time to waste. You need to make a wise decision shortly. It is supposed, at least for the majority of people, to choose the way of salvation. The question is why! The answer is that hope exists with salvation and despair exists with damnation, therefore hope which influenced your first choice, it forced you now to choose rightly because the time is running short.

Think about hope and the devil! Are they connected with each other? I think there is a big relationship between the two. The devil invested hopes to raise procrastination in your mind to make you unintentionally feel that life is still too long, and you have much more important issues to think about than thinking about salvation.

In the second case, the shortness of time and lack of chances blocked the way before the devil. You can't allow the devil to intervene because you are thinking seriously. You are required to make up your mind in a very short time. Here, you try to get the best solution and choose successfully with the shortest possible time.

I advise you to consider salvation and damnation along with this example. If you do, you must thank God because you did the right thing before it is too late. If you reject the whole idea or procrastinate then you must remember that life may last long, and it may end unexpectedly in seconds.

Now, we have options, but the very options may disappear in a few moments.

However, what I mentioned in this book became like a mathematical equation: (If there is a universe \rightarrow there must be a creator \rightarrow and if there is a creator \rightarrow there must be afterlife in the heavens because He proved that with clear signs and examples about how He gives life to creatures). This is because the Creator who created the universe, humanity, and everything else told us about our worldly life, death, and the afterlife which is waiting for us.

Currently, we are aware of the first two because we experienced the first one and see people experiencing the second one every day, but we are still waiting for the next one which is immortality.

According to that, salvation and damnation are part of your choice since you have full control over your behaviors and deeds. You need just to think logically before you choose. Think also that damnation track is easier and more tempting than the salvation track because the devil is there and always tries to tempt you and guide you to the wrong track, the track of damnation. The track of salvation needs patience in addition to avoiding certain practices that you might like. During life, you write the story that will lead you to one of the two tracks and so do all the other people since everyone goes through the same test.

At the end of the test, there will be winners and losers. Just think and decide to select the team that you would like to join. If you would like to join the team of salvation, you have to do what is required for that and if you prefer to join the team of damnation, you also know the things that cause damnation particularly after going through the pages of this book. Think logically and neutrally before you choose. I wish all readers and all people everywhere a lucky choice to save themselves and enjoy a happy life on the earth now and on our first homeland, paradise, later.
